The below table outlines expenditure for the 2023/2024 financial year. Summary of FY2024 Redress for abuse expenses paid



Counselling	55,318.01
Legal expenses (National redress and civil claims)	207,774.36
Payments to UCA Redress Ltd	122,763.40
National redress settlements to applicants	2,887,039.01
Recoveries from Frederick Marsden Youth Centre	(219,710.32)
Insurance recoveries	(17,700.00)
Lump sum settlements to claimants under civil cases	450,000.00

Invoices have been calculated based on the average of total revenue and the insured value of property (building and contents excluding motor vehicles) – this calculations methodology has been consistently applied since the start of the Recovery Scheme.
