- Child safety and wellbeing is embedded in organisational leadership, governance and culture
- 2 Children and young people are informed about their rights, participate in decisions affecting them and are taken seriously
- 3 Families and communities are informed and involved in promoting child safety and wellbeing
- Diversity is respected and equity is promoted
- Our people are suitable for work with children, hold a blue card, and are committed to the values of child safety and wellbeing
- Child focused complaints processes
- Our people are provided with ongoing education and training on child safety
- 8 Physical and online environments promote safety
- 9 Policies and procedures document child safety
- Review and continuous improvement of policy, procedure and practice

We are committed to the physical, emotional, and spiritual welfare and safety of all people. We trust and pray that your relationship with our congregation is uplifting, enriching and safe.

We encourage people to speak up, raise concerns and provide feedback. This helps us to know when people are feeling safe and when they are not.
