



Recognition of Prior Learning

C/2.1.6

Purpose

Provides a structure and outlines the criteria required to receive Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and comply with the [Safe Church Policy](#). Complements the [Safe Church Training Procedure](#).

Scope

This procedure applies to all workers (paid and volunteer) within the Queensland Synod.

Process

1. Once the [application for RPL](#) is received and processed by the Safe Church Assurance and Support Officer, you will be advised of the outcome, usually within 3 business days.
 - 1.1. A signed copy of the outcome of the application will be provided to you, and a copy also provided to the Presbytery if applicable.
2. Keep a record of your approved RPL and give a copy to the church council or presbytery as proof of training compliance for their records.
3. Note: The *Safe Church Introduction* course is mandatory and RPL is not available.

RPL: Child Protection

4. People whose roles require them to complete annual child protection training or who work directly under child protection legislation, may apply for RPL for the *Safe Church Foundations* course.

Evidence of Prior Training

5. To obtain RPL for the *Safe Church Foundations* course, you must provide proof of completion of child protection training from a recognised training program or institution, **within the last year**
 - 5.1. Certificate of completion of a relevant course, obtained from a recognised training program or institution; and transcript of the units covered in the course.

Recognition of Professional Skills

6. The applicant must have held **two years** of continuous employment **within the last three years** in one of the listed roles below: (you will be required to attach evidence as proof of qualification or role)
 - 6.1. Registered Teacher
 - 6.1.1. Proof of Queensland teacher registration or proof of teacher registration from another Australian state or territory
 - 6.2. Police Officer
 - 6.2.1. Queensland police identification or police identification from another Australian state or territory.
 - 6.3. Childcare/ Educator
 - 6.3.1. Proof of childcare identification and relevant qualification from Queensland
 - 6.4. Other Professional roles
 - 6.4.1. Proof of ministry identification from Queensland or from another Australian state or territory, with evidence of a completed qualification from a recognised institution as supporting evidence.



- 6.4.2. Proof of general practitioner or medical doctor registration (e.g. Australian Health Practitioners Association).
- 6.4.3. Proof of child protection identification from Queensland or from another Australian state or territory
- 6.4.4. Other - Contact the Safe Church Assurance and Support Officer to discuss suitability for RPL.

RPL: Other Training

- 7. RPL is available for most Safe Church courses if the training completed is comparable, or similar enough to the content in the Safe Church course.
- 8. An application for RPL can be made for other Safe Church courses (*except Section 3 above*), using evidence of training completed at another program or institution **within the last year**.
 - 8.1. Provide a Certificate of completion of the training; and transcript of the units or an official summary of the content covered in the training.
 - 8.2. The training institution must be a recognised institution such as a college, university, or Tafe within Australia.
