

Placements Committee

Purpose

To outline the information that must be considered by the Placements Committee when creating a new placement.

Scope

The process applies to the creation of new placements within a congregation, Presbytery or the Synod of the Uniting Church in Australia, Queensland Synod.

Process

A request to create a new placement must be made to the Placements Committee by:

- the Presbytery, if the call is to be issued by a congregation or Presbytery
- the relevant Synod body, if the call is to be issued by the Synod.

The request must be accompanied by a rationale for the new placement, including:

- 1. the aim and purpose of the placement (if not in the position description)
- 2. the field of ministry of the placement (if not in the position description)
- 3. how the placement fits with the Presbytery or Synod body's strategic intent
- 4. how the placement contributes to the mission of the church in Queensland
- 5. how the funding base is constructed
- 6. a draft position description for non-congregational placements.

In making its determination the Placements Committee will consider the duties of a minister as outlined in Regulation 2.2.1 (a).
